## E-J Electric Installation Co. Electricians Rise to the Challenge

E-J Electric Installation Co. (E-J) just completed the JetBlue Terminal 5 project at JFK International Airport.

The project included a new \$746 million, 635,000 s/f, 26-gate passenger terminal behind the 1962 historic landmark Eero Saarinen-designed TWA Terminal.

Throughout the new terminal facility, E-J installed the A/V and miscellaneous electrical equipment package that included all flight, baggage, information, and television displays.

Also put in place were 200 LCD monitors with custom mounting applications, e-ticket kiosks, baggage scales, check-in and gate counter ticketing computer equipment.

E-J also provided the electrical installation of the 15,000-foot conveyor baggage handling system with integrated security systems and control panels, along with all conduit, wiring and control devices, and installed related devices such as photo eyes, start-stop stations and motors.

Anthony Mann, president of E-J, commented, "We were proud to be part of the JetBlue team and to provide electrical construction work for such a landmark airport project.

"Our work included a wide range of electrical services, including low voltage, data, fire safety and supplemental power from three generators, and we were pleased to be able to respond to the challenge and to be part of such an exciting, complex construction assignment."
